

Foot Health: The Role of the Support Worker

Course Outline

Total Hours: 15

The Foot Health course is designed for new and experienced support workers, health care aides and individuals acting in a supportive role to a family or community member who wish to update their knowledge of foot health and define their role within a health care team. This course provides a theoretical foundation which follows current best practice guidelines and evidence-based practice, including the Canadian Association of Support Worker's (CASW) Standards, IPAC Canada, Diabetes Canada, Wounds Canada. This course is also recommended for patients and their families living with diabetes.
